

“Occupational exposure at Japanese Nuclear Power Plant in 2006”
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Reporting of the summary of the occupational exposure at nuclear power stations in Japan in fiscal 2006. The average collective dose/unit for BWRs has been decreasing for the last three years and hit a record low in fiscal 2006 at 1.33 man·Sv. The average collective dose/unit for PWRs remains stable at 1 man·Sv.

Given the relatively longer interval of periodical inspections compared with other countries, it is expected that the ongoing inspection system review promotes the reduction in the exposure of the plant in Japan.
