Revision of Regulation for Radiation Exposure on Emergency Workers

During accident of Fukushima Daiichi, dose limit of emergency response staff was changed from 100mSv to 250mSv. Although the dose limit is returned to 100mSv now, it is important that prepare for the accident beyond 100mSv for the worth. Therefore, NRA starts investigation about the measures of radiation exposure for emergency workers on 30 July 2014. NRA approved the revision of the regulation and ordinance on 5 August.

This presentation show background of the revision, a summary of investigation of regulation of emergency workers abroad, point of revision of the regulation in Japan, bases of dose limit of 250mSv and schedule for revision of the regulation.
