Improvement of the Labor Environment at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

At Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station, fuel removal from Unit 4 SFP had been completed on December 2014. Now, we have been removing large rubble within Unit 3 from SFP. Preparatory works to remove fuel from Unit 1-3 SFP and fuel debris removal are ongoing.

In such situation, the number of workers per day is approx. 8,000 and it will be expected to increase. For this reason, improvement of the labor environment is significant impact on the future of decommissioning work.

In this presentation, it will specifically be described on the following 4 points and the progress status at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station.

- ① Plan to reduce radiation dose
- 2 Expansion of area where full-face masks need not to be worn
- ③ Installation of Dose Rate Monitors within Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station
- ④ Large rest house

Through these efforts, we are committed to make steady progress in the decommissioning work safely.
